


## WINE LIST



### White

#### **Mercurius Malagouzia**

**Price:**

Dry wine. A collaboration of Mercurius with the Chateau Kaniaris. Variety Malagouzia. Golden yellow colour with expressive varietal aroma and taste of peach, pear, green pepper and notes of flowers and royal. Mouth large, good acidity and lasting aftertaste.

#### **Moschofilero Boutaris**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Moschofilero is a refreshing dry white wine with enticing citrus, floral and melon aromas. Boutaris' moschofilero grapes are grown in vineyards in the Mantinia region of the Peloponnese at the optimal altitude of 650 meters. The result is a crisp, fresh, well-balanced wine.

#### **Samaropetra Kyr Yianni**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Blend of mountain Roditis and Sauvignon Blanc, from the vineyards of Samaropetra. The combination of cold microclimate and poor limy soil creates the perfect terroir for the cultivation of aromatic white grapes.

#### **Biblia Chora**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Varietal composition Assyrtiko 40% and Sauvignon Blanc 60%. A gentle, yellow-green colour of remarkable clarity. The marriage of the cosmopolitan and fragrant Sauvignon with Greek Assyrtiko produces a wine with a powerful aroma redolent of exotic fruit, peach and citrus. A rich, cool and beautifully balanced flavour, pleasant acidity and a lasting, fragrant aftertaste.

#### **Alpha Estate Malagouzia**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Brilliantly, light yellow in colour with greenish tints. Strong and lively nose, typical Sauvignon Blanc, suggesting gooseberry, passion fruits, melon, litchi with a note of honeysuckle. Round and mellow on the palate, quite fat balanced although, with plenty of finesse. Crispy and well structured, reminding the nose aromas with a hint of lime. A richly textured wine with superb length and balance. A classy wine with long finish and persistent aromas.

## Rosè

### **Mercurius Rosè**

**Price:**

Dry wine. A collaboration of Mercurius with the Chateau Kaniaris. Variety Syrah 100%. Soft reddish colour; taste and aroma of wild strawberry, pomegranate and gooseberry; balanced acidity.

### **Meliasto Spiropoulos**

Dry wine. Made from carefully selected Moschofilero grapes grown on the organic Domaine Spiropoulos vineyards and from small selected quantities of organically grown Agiorgitiko grapes, Meliasto has characteristic flavours of rose and of strawberry caramel. With well-balanced and outstandingly pleasant flavour.

## Red

### **Mercurius Syrah**

**Price:**

Dry wine. A collaboration of Mercurius with the Chateau Kaniaris. Variety Syrah. Deep red colour with iodine tones, red fruit and dried prune bouquet, rich taste with discreet barrel scent

### **Agiorgitiko Boutaris**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Agiorgitiko Boutaris is produced from carefully selected vineyards of Leontio and Ancient Nemea in the Peloponnese. The particular microclimate of the region, coupled with the most contemporary techniques of viticulture and vilification, result in a deep-colored red wine, with aromas of red fruits, vanilla and cocoa, rich body and smooth taste.

### **Paranga Kyr Yianni**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Winemaker Yiannis Boutaris highlights spice and fruits foremost in this lightest one among his blends of Xinomavro -the intriguing indigenous Greek red grape- with Merlot and Syrah.

### **Grande Reserve Boutaris**

**Price:**

Dry wine. Aged in barrel. Selected grapes from the variety of Xinomavro, is wine which aged for four years in oak barrels and bottles. It can be further ageing. Rich wine with deep red colour. Sweets aromas of dried fruits, specially tomatoes and figs are combined with these from ageing, such as cinnamon, vanilla, woods and spices.

The aura of Lake Plastira gave another dimension to these two varieties that offer an ethereal white wine with a glittering golden-yellow colour, with refined aromas of banana, pear and other yellow fruits, which involves the palate but also the imagination ...



### Le Petite Cirque Rosé

An evergreen rosé wine from the historical variety "Black Mesenikola" from the mountain vineyards of the homonymous village. Its authentic flavour has a balanced sweetness, like balancing the pair of its label on a bicycle wheel ...

The heady smells of rose petals and the senses of fresh fruit, the colour of the pink and the orange, leave the imagination to travel in moments of nostalgia, moments of another era, creating feelings of joy and euphoria.
